Background and Goals

- Ensure regulations align with current clinical practices
- Flexibility to meet the needs of the diverse population
- Competency-based approach
- Allows the resident to maintain or attain their highest practicable physical, mental, and psychosocial well being

Facility Assessment

- Requiring facilities to assess their facility capabilities and their resident population
- Competency-based approach is compatible with existing business practices

Facility Assessment Regulation

- (1) The facility's resident population
- (2) The facility's resources
- (3) A facility-based and community-based risk assessment, utilizing an all-hazards approach.
